STOP THE WAR AGAINST THE MOHAWKS!

The municipality of Oka in Quebec, Canada is attemting to expand a 9-hole golf course to 18 holes on a Mohawk sacred burial site. This land has already been purchased by the Canadian federal government for the Mohawk people.

In response, the Mohawks have erected barricades around their reservation to prevent the construction of the golf course. The Canadian & Quebec governments have surrounded the Mohawks with police & army troops. 4400 Canadian troops surround the mohawks.

The Canadian government finally opened negotiations with the Mohawk people, but it has refused to negotiate in good faith.

THE CANADIAN ARMY "ACCIDENTALLY" DROPPED A PHOSPHOROUS BOMD ON THE MOHAWK RESERVATION WITH THE EXCUSE"TO ERR IS HUMAN."

THE GOVERNMENT HAS REPEATEDLY BROKEN IT'S PROMISES TO LET FOOD & MEDICAL SUPPLIES INTO THE RESERVATION.

THE MOHAWKS ARE SUBJECT TO ARBITRARY ARRESTS, BEATINGS & TORTURE BY THE POLICE & ARMY.MANY MOHAWKS HAVE "DISAPPEARED."

THE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT HAS ASKED INTERNATIONAL OBSERVERS TO LEAVE THE DISPUTED TERRITORIES THE ARMY HAS THREATENED SEVERAL TIMES TO INVADE MOHAWK TERRITORY & START A BLOODBATH OVER A GOLF COURSE.

WHITE SUPREMACIST GROUPS IN CANADA ARE ORGANIZING AROUND THE MOHAWK DISPUTE.

A new chapter of the Klu Klux Klan has been formed in the disputed territories. Canadian law enforcers have refused to intervene with white racists attacks against Indian people.

WHITE RACIST GROUPS HAVE OPENED FIRE REPEATEDLY IN THE MOHAWK ENCAMPMENT IN ORDER TO START GUN FIGHTS.

WHITE RACIST ARE BEATING ANYONE IN THE AREA WHO LOOKS EVEN REMOTELY INDIAN. THEY ARE ALSO BURNING EFFIGIES OF INDIANS.

WHITE RACIST GROUPS HAVE DEVISED A PLAN TO SNEAK INTO MOHAWK ENCAMPMENT & SHOOT AT POLICE OFFICERS SO THAT THESE SHOOTINGS WILL BLAMED ON THE MOHAWKS.

ONE WOMAN WHO WAS HEMORRHAGING, ATTEMPTED TO LEAVE THE MOHAWK RESERVATION WHEN HER AMBULANCE WAS STOPPED BY WHITE VIGILANTES. THEY DETAINED THE AMBULANCE FOR TWO HOURS WHILE CANADIAN POLICE REFUSED TO INTERVENE. SHE WAS NOT ALLOWED TO PASS UNTIL THE WHITE VIGILANTES "EXAMINED" HER TO SEE IF SHE WAS REALLY HEMORRHAGING. BY THE TIME SHE REACHED THE HOSPITAL, SHE WAS IN CRITCAL CONDITION.

martin: tell me about what your songs mean. kevin: how about abysmal yellow popcorn wall? craig: it's about the sour aspect of love and the title has nothing to do with the song, we just all threw in an extraneous to give it a name.

kevin: what about touch?

craig: i was thinking about this girl who i was obsessed with for a while who was really fucked up. and because she was such a mess, i was all the more drawn to her, sucked into her and her name was meredith. it's just about her and how fucked up she was.

mike: vampire's proposal is an anne rice sort of song, it's not as vague lyrically. kevin: what about it was arson?

eraig: that has no meaning, it just came out. the music always comes first and then something comes out of my mouth. sometimes they're words and they're usually so vidiculous.

mike: i thought arson was about cats catching on fire..

(general laughter)

craig: well, yea but the lyrics just happened to come out and i thought they were cool.

martin: your style of music and your (to craig) craig: which is cool, because it's broken down voice is unique. people might say "wow,

thats really weird or different" or whatever. how do people usually respond to you at shows?

chris: just like that sometimes, maybe the majority of the people at a show are like that or maybe no one is. it depends on what they're going to pick at and it also depends on what types of music that they're open to. 'open mind'is a worn out phrase, it's like come and listen and do you like it or not. not, it's good, but... stuart: a lot of people will say " i heard

your album and i hated it at first but then i gave it another listen and now it's-

stuart: no, i'll quote them 'now i think you guys are great!

mike: and stuart actually heard that, once. martin: how do describe your sound to people? stuart: i usually just say that we're a hard, guitar oriented, melodic outfit:

craig: outfit, i like that.

mike: yea, like polyester.

stuart: four human beings molded together to form a hard rock attack on the world.

martin: do you guys cringe if you have to play with hardcore bands?

craig: it depends. it's really hard a lot of times to play for a straight edge crowd. immediately there is a predjudice. a lot of times there is totally cool people, but there is also a lot of closemindedness.

wike: but even now you may look at a lot of bands and say "they're just straight edge" or whatever and you may think you know what's coming but a lot of bands are using different melodies and experimenting somewhat and it surprises you and you think "that's really cool".

a lot of my predjudices about some music and playing shows for some crowds.

martin: what was your idea of what tonight would be like?

craig: i didn't know.

mike: sometimes you don't know whether it's going to be punk rock or a college happyhour crowd.

stuart: the best thing about the crowd tonight was that although it was small, it seemed that everyone really got into it.

craig:yea the initial excitement of punk made me say "oh my god! i can do whatever i want and i never have to stop!" one of the most exciting moments in my

life was when i first heard the sex pistols because i had been listening to blue ovster cult and i was like" fucking this rocks, this is great, whatever 's hard man!" and the sex pistols made me say "this is all i want to do"

stuart: to me, just playing the songs we wrote is so great and i do alot of the booking and meeting people and that's cool.afrer ຂe 🛰 practice and practice and work on songs and people actually like it, it's a good feeling. playing in front of an appreciative audience makes

it seem like it's all worth it. and also listening to our studio recordings, it's great to hear it and say "we did this" and just listen to what we're all playing.

eralg: It reinforces me to have an audience that likes us and I think that I'm not just being totally egocentric when i like our songs.

people threw bottles at you and called you names? would you keep being shudder to think? craig: shows that suck are ones that everyone is stone-faced and just staring, not interested at all. if they're listening and hating it, at least there's some response, if people hated us day in and day out, then it would definately change our perspective. but i think to move someone, one way or the other, is a reinforcing thing.


martin: what do you guys do besides the band? craig: i'm going to school at n.y.u. and i took a year off. i'm studying a lot of music, theater, art, etc. alot of experimental stuff that i think influences me and helps the amount of energy and creativity that i bring into the band. my influences are not just punk or hardcore. i want creative freedom and i think i've found that. and also totally loving rock and roll and fusing the two.

stuart: i study liguistics at university of maryland, i finished my third year and now i'm taking a year off.

chris:i just finished school, studied anthropology. besides that, not much of anything except the band.









What's wrong with McDonald's?

Behind the cheerful, Smiling face of Ronald McDonald, beyond the lies of the happy, fun place where meat comes from "hamburger patches" in "McDonaldland" there hides the horrible truth about McDonalds: The worldwide exploitation of people, animals and the Earth. To children, McDonalds is a happy place, filled with bright colors and clowns, silly goblins and talking hamburgers that enjoy being eaten. To adults, McDonalds is a convenience, "fast food." But the real (ruth is far from pleasant and once you've read this leaflet you'll never want to go into a McDonald's (or Burger King, etc.) again:

\$\$\$ STARVING THE POOR. McDonalds owns huge amounts of land in poor countries like Costa Rica. While millions go undernourished, staple crops are fed to cattle, which are then made into hamburgers for the 'developed world'- - a process known as "hamburgerization." Animals eat more grain than humans: 145 million tons fed to livestock produce only 21 million tons of meat and meat by-products. Land, energy and water requirements for the production of meat range anywhere from 10 to 1000 times greater than those necessary to produce an equal amount of plant food. Here in America most of the farming land is used for grain production to

be fed to cattle, not directly to humans. So while some people eat the 'luxury' of meat, many others eat nothing at all. It's no exaggeration to say that when you bite into a Big Mac, you are literally stealing from the mouths of the

hungry.

\$\$\$ DESTROYING THE EARTH. The world's beautiful rainforests are being destroyed at an amazingly fast rate by companies like McDonald's and Burger King, who use deadly poisons to clear the jungle for cattle ranching. There are 100,000 cattle ranches in Amazonia and it takes 800 sq. miles of forest just to keep McDonalds supplied with paper for one year. Loss of trees and forests means rain is not absorbed, causing flooding, soil erosion and desert within five years. The whole process causes at least one species of plant or animal to become extinct every four hours. Plus, tribal people who have lived peacefully on these lands for thousands of years are being forced off.

\$\$\$.SLAUGHTER OF THE INNOCENT. McDonald's menu is based upon the murder of millions of animals. They die horrible deaths, often remaining fully conscious while having their throats slit due to inefficient stunning. We have the choice to eat meat, but the 300 million cattle and calves and 3 billion chickens slaughtered for food each year have no choice at all. 'Big Mac' and 'Chicken McNugget' are but mere euphimisms for senseless death. Could you yourself kill the animals that McDonakis calls 'food?'

\$\$\$ RUINING YOUR HEALTH. McDonald's food, like most junk food, is high in animal fat, sugar and salt, and low in fiber, a diet which in numerous health reports and experiments has been linked to heart disease, cancer, diabetes and arthritis. It's also full of chemical additives (to disguise the terrible taste). Junk food produces obesity because although it is high in calories, it

lacks bulk and fiber and hence induces overeating.

\$\$\$ EXPLOITING THEIR EMPLOYEES. Working in McDonald's and similar fast food restaurants means low pay and bad conditions. Worker turnover rate is 80%. McDonald's has long resisted trade unions, though a recent survey of their staff said they wanted to be in a union. Most of their workers are under 21 and black, people with little chance of finding alternative jobs -- to McDonald's, an endless supply of cheap labor.

What you can do: Stop patronizing McDonald's and other similar fast food restaurants. There are plenty of alternatives to eating the death and destruction McDonald's calls food. Picketing and a little of that old direct action never fails to call attention to a problem. Do whatever you can. Most importantly, be aware. Consider becoming a vegetarian if you haven't already. QUESTION EVERYTHING, McDonald's makes death and devastation seem like fun and games. Think how sick it is for McDonald's to hide the real truth from children. Look below the surface and the reality is not fun and games.


